on October 14, 2006. Setup will start at 8:00 a.m., registration is at 9:00 a.m., lunch will be provided, and we should be done by 3:30 pm. I will need the following information from you on or before October 8th. I cannot make any exceptions after this date, so please get me your info on time. I do not want to leave any boy out, so this is very important. If your boys do not meet the point totals for testing, you can send your top two boys from each age group. Every boy in attendance will receive either a participation ribbon, Excellent ROTY medallion or an Outstanding ROTY medallion.

I will collect the evaluation forms at registration as well as \$15 registration fee on the day of the testing. The evaluation form is part of the scoring so it is very important that the boys show up with their forms.
